They have successfully moved into their new home and they are really happy, we are currently working on resettlement and budgeting, they even have their own file which they are keeping all their letter in. Person A seems to be more active and is doing a lot of walking with Emma, she is opening up even more in regards to her mental health and feels ready to talk about it and do something about it. Person A and Emma have big plans for the flat deciding on what colours to put up on the wall etc and they are positively thinking about their future together.</p>
